We would like to let you know about the 'Bunny Hop' which Kelbrook Primary School has kindly agreed to take part in this year to help raise funds for Pendleside Hospice.

Your child will be joining in with a sponsored jog on **Thursday 4th April at 1.15pm**. This event is designed to be a fun, physical activity that the children can enjoy taking part in with their friends, but it will also give them an opportunity to learn about the work of the hospice.

As well as this letter, your child will have received an envelope which they can collect their sponsorship in. Sponsorship for the Bunny Hop is not compulsory, however we would ask that each child makes a minimum contribution of £1.50 to cover Hospice costs for this event. Please complete the envelope with your child's name and school's details on, so that we can count the money correctly.

Each child will receive a set of bunny ears, an Easter treat and a certificate for taking part.

The hospice cares for people who have been diagnosed with cancer or any other life limiting illnesses and supports their family and carers. We are able to do this thanks to the support of the local community, which raises £3.2 million towards annual running costs of £4.2 million.
