Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you all had a great summer break and I would like to welcome you back to the academic year of 2018-2019. Miss McClinton had her baby over the summer and named her Lola. Mother and baby are doing well.

Ady's sports clubs started this week with KS1 Football on Monday, KS2 Netball on Tuesday and KS1 Multi Skills on Wednesday. It is not too late to sign your children up to these clubs. Ring the office to put their names down. All clubs finish at 4:30pm.

ICAN with Miss Alice on Tuesday and Friday starts next week (week beginning Monday 10th September along with Running with Mrs Townson, Gardening with Mrs Brice and Choir with Mrs Opacic. Again, ring the office to put your child's name down if you would like them to take part.

As this is the beginning of the new academic year each class has been writing their class charters, revisiting school rules and getting ready to vote for our Head Girl and Boy and School Council Members. School Council asked that when it's a pupils birthday if they can wear non- uniform. We think this is a lovely idea but we have decided to have our birthday non-uniform day as Friday. So, if your child has had a birthday since Friday 20th July 2018 they can come to school in non-uniform on Friday 7th September. After that any child having a birthday from Saturday to Friday will be able to wear non-uniform on the following Friday that week. Of course if they don't want to take up the opportunity to not wear their uniform that is absolutely fine with school.

Lots of new uniform has been purchased and the children look very smart. Please can I ask that names or just initials are written in jumpers, cardigans and all other uniform including PE kits as we had a vast amount of lost property at the end of the last year. A label that has been recommended by a parent is available at www.easy2name.com. With equality in mind we have updated and streamlined our school uniform to the following -





- Dark grey trousers or a skirt (The skirt should be knee length or just above. No tube skirts or leggings). We accept there will be a transition period before all the children are wearing dark grey.
- White polo shirt
- Jade sweatshirt or cardigan (with a school logo).
- Shoes - sensible, black
- Socks - white or grey
- Tights - grey
- Summer uniforms is a checked jade and white dress or dark grey shorts with either a jade sweatshirt or cardigan. (The shorts should be just above the knee. No hot-pants allowed).
- No jewellery except for small stud earrings and watches should be worn for school and make-up and nail varnish are not permitted.
- Hair should be tied back at all times and clips/headbands should be small and plain.

PE Kit consists of:

- White T-shirt, Shorts navy, Pumps (trainers for outdoors as required), Outdoors - a tracksuit may be worn over the white t-shirt and navy shorts or a school sweatshirt or cardigan may be worn.

And finally, I have timetabled 'Meet the Teacher' meeting with your child's class teacher. These are sessions where you can visit your child's class and meet their teacher. They will go through timetables, routines and the curriculum for the class. It's also an opportunity for you to have your questions answered. If you cannot make these after school meetings a letter will be sent home containing all the relevant information. This will also be uploaded to the class page on the website.
